#### **Position Description**

As a leading Australian sport organisation, Squash Australia is committed to having a diverse Board that not only reflects the Australian community but has the required skills, competencies, gender and experience to lead the growth and development of squash Australia-wide. To reflect this commitment Squash Australia has established a Nominations Committee ('Committee') to guide the selection of

candidates that present for appointment or election to the Board having regard to any legal or policy requirements, the current skillset of the Board and the strategic direction of Squash Australia.

The Independent Chair of the Squash Australia Nominations Committee is a constitutionally established role that is responsible for overseeing this function and for ensuring that independent judgement is brought to guide the skills competencies and experience to lead the growth and development of Squash Australia-wide.

In performing its role, the Independent Chair of the Nominations Committee is responsible for:

- supporting the consideration and selection of suitable candidates for appointment or election to positions on the Board of Squash Australia
- supporting the Board of Squash Australia to identify the required mix of skills, expertise, competencies, gender and experience to lead the growth and development of squash Australia-wide
- performing functions assigned to the Committee by the Board of Squash Australia (from time to time)

The appointment will be for 2 years in length, and aligned with the National AGM dates.

Squash Australia is seeking a candidate with a skill set to suit the role of Chair of the Nominations Committee. The successful candidate will possess the following attributes:

- Strong understanding of governance requirements relating to the appointment and election of Board Directors
- Experience in briefing Board members on organisational and governance matters

- AICD qualified (desirable)
